Reminder - PPA Deadline Approaching

The Authority is currently accepting Preliminary Project Assessments (PPA) on a rolling basis and will close the portal for 2019 9% PPA's on November 9, 2018. The Authority intends to inform sponsors of PPA status no later than December 21, 2018. 2019 9% LIHTC Applications will be due February 15, 2019.
