RE: Extension of State and Federal Prohibitions on Evictions

SUMMARY:

Federal prohibitions on evictions set to expire on March 3 ft have been extended through June 30, 2021. State prohibitions also continue to be in effect at least through April 3, 2021.

Federal Prohibitions:

As described in <u>IHDA Management Bulletin #508</u>, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) issued a national prohibition on residential evictions for nonpayment of rent. The CDC also provides a model <u>declaration form</u> for tenants seeking protection under the federal order. On March 29th, the CDC issued a <u>revised order</u>, extending the prohibition for 90 days.

State Restrictions:

In the State of Illinois, Governor Pritzker's <u>Executive Order 2020-72</u> prohibits the commencement and enforcement of residential evictions, except in cases where the tenant poses a direct threat to the health and safety of other tenants, or an immediate and severe risk to the property.

The Governor has extended the order every 30 days. Mostly recently, <u>Executive Order 2021-05</u> extends the prohibition **through April 3**, **2021**. Landlords should check the State of Illinois <u>webpage</u> for additional extensions.
