



## Deadline Approaching for Housing For Justice Involved Individuals Funding Round

March 2, 2022

The Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA) is now accepting applications under its [Housing for Justice Involved Individuals \(HJIIP\) Program](#). Applicants can request up to \$475,000 per project to fund the acquisition, new construction, and/or rehabilitation of housing that serves individuals exiting the criminal justice system, jail, or prison. Housing is intended to be transitional and provide appropriate supportive services to facilitate the movement into permanent housing.
