SUMMARY:

Effective January 1, 2022, Senate Bill 154 amended the Illinois Affordable Housing Act to allow very-low or low-income residents to keep up to two cats or one dog that weighs less than 50 pounds regardless of breed or height.

This provision is applicable to residents of apartments at least 500 sq. ft. in size in a multifamily building that has been acquired, built, or rehabbed utilizing Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Fund money after the effective date.
