Summary:

This position is housed with the Strategic Planning and Reporting (SPAR) department, which is where IHDA's most important research is conceptualized and developed. SPAR uses market research to inform key decisions made by IHDA, while paying special attention to the social impact we have on communities across the state of Illinois, in both the short and long terms.

The Data Analyst is responsible for maintaining and updating the database of record while preserving data integrity. This individual will produce routine and ad hoc reports regarding IHDA's various housing production programs. The data analyst will be forward-thinking and regularly contribute to SPAR's efforts to remain on the leading edge of housing research and reporting.

Essential Functions:

- Maintain and update Access-based database used as database of record.
- Assist with the intaking of applications for funding through proprietary software and provide technical assistance to applicants of IHDA resources.
- Understanding of fundamentals required to build and/or run queries within database software, primarily Microsoft Access, to respond to data requests from within IHDA in addition to external requests.
- Utilize programs such as Microsoft Excel and Power BI to produce reports and data analyses, both routine and ad hoc, for use by all IHDA departments.

- Identify, report, and troubleshoot errors in data flows and collaborate with team and across departments to resolve or optimize process.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE and SKILLS REQUIREMENTS:

Two years of related data analysis experience and/or college degree are preferred. Candidates must have experience with recent versions of Microsoft Office Suite, especially Excel and Access.
