Contributes to the leadership of the IT Department.

Responsibilities:

Managing cloud-based servers, storage, networks, databases, email, and this includes cloud adoption, cloud Infrastructure design, cloud management, monitoring, and its deployment in a cloud-based environment.

Maintain all aspects of IHDA core physical infrastructure, including but not limited to data centers, physical servers, virtual servers, systems monitoring systems, routing, switching, telecom, disaster recovery, backup and restore, low-voltage office circuitry, wide area network

Design and Configure Cloud infrastructures related to the Microsoft Office 365 and Azure and to support Cloud migrations and transformation initiatives.

Ensure compliance with all applicable laws, regulation, and policies

Defines, documents, and implements robust enterprise technical architectures based on industry best practices in support of IHDA business goals.

Assist IT Operations team to ensure that all IHDA data is securely backed up and stored per IHDA policy and industry best practices

Work closely with the Service Desk, IT Operations and Security/Resiliency teams to ensure that the technical activities across the Authority are well coordinated and executed with the least possible impact on the business partners

Oversee the procurement, deployment, maintenance, and disposal of all internally facing technologies including, but not limited to servers, routers, switches, data center components and data center software

Develop and maintain base-zero budget (Expense and Capital) for area of responsibility, and participate in the development and tracking of the departmental budget.

Liaise with the security and risk management functions in the Authority to ensure that the technology solutions deployed and supported are secure and compliant with all applicable laws, regulations, and policies.
