RE:	The VAWA Reauthorization Act of 2022 (VAWA 2022)

SUMMARY:

The Office of Multifamily and Asset Management within the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued a <u>memorandum</u> dated March 10, 2023, on the new Housing Provisions of the Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization Act of 2022. This release follows <u>President Biden's Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2022</u>.

As highlighted in HUD's memorandum, VAWA 2022 reauthorizes, amends, and strengthens VAWA. It added to and did not replace the existing VAWA housing protections for survivors. As a covered housing provider, you must continue to provide VAWA protections as required by law. Many of the amendments enacted as part of VAWA 2022 took effect on October 1, 2022. Read here about the history and origins of VAWA.
