Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA), one of the Nation's preeminent Housing Finance Agencies and one of the State's ten largest financial institutions, is currently seeking a Director of Strategic Initiatives & Response to build upon their 50+ year leadership in housing finance.

Summary:

The Director of Strategic Initiatives & Response will have a dual role and will develop, oversee, and implement programs and projects that support the Illinois Housing Development Authority's vision and short- and long-term strategic plans. At the direction of the Executive Director, the Director of Strategic Initiatives & Response will suggest or advocate to manage new housing initiatives throughout the state of Illinois. As the new public facing department of the authority, the Strategic Response department will address the housing initiatives/projects as directed by the Executive team.

SRU is currently operating emergency housing assistance programs directly to individual households and related parties that provide stability across the state. Investment in detail is key for the operational elements of the role of the Director. While directing the public relations operations between the Strategic Response Unit and external partners, the Director will regularly evaluate and develop program operations within the department, ascertaining adequate productivity and workflow ratios, and serving as final say on all reports and numbers published by the department. These responsibilities will entail heavy collaboration with the Assistant Directors and Managers through a data-driven approach. Given the urgent nature of assistance offered through the department's programs, the Director must be knowledgeable about and motivated by ongoing program impacts.

Essential Functions:

- Provide strategic advice to members of the executive team, including the Executive Director, Chief of Staff, Communications Director, Director of Innovation and External Affairs Director.
- Work with the Director of External Relations on crafting the Authority's legislative agenda. Advocate for Authority projects and legislative initiatives, build and maintain relationships with elected officials.
- Manage a variety of tasks in a fast-paced environment and direct other Authority staff toward a common goal. Provide ongoing guidance to senior staff and department directors around critical policy matters and operational issues.
- Make recommendations of new policy initiatives and then guide and assist program directors and managers in defining program scope; developing program model, goals and deliverables; identifying regulatory requirements; assessing regulatory and budgetary impact; identifying performance metrics and evaluation criteria.
- Skillful in analyzing facts regarding all initiatives within the Strategic Response Unit, conditions, and policies; strives to improve operations through developing clearly defined policies and procedures; makes timely decisions; offers workable decision alternatives to superiors for issues.

Education & Experience Requirements:

Undergraduate Degree in Business, Finance, Economics, or Political Science is required or MBA or other advanced degree desired or commensurate experience (7 year minimum) in government relations, community development or related field, with experience in program management and leading teams of professional staff. Excellent written and oral presentation skills required. Knowledge and proficiency of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, is required. Database familiarity desired.
