
Amenities and Assets Map Template PID_12345

- 4. Identify the CRSA's amenities, institutions, assets, and affordable housing developments by placing the corresponding icon onto the map.
 - a. Copy the icon from the legend
 - b. Paste it onto the correct location on the map
 - c. If there is more than one amenity, asset, or institution in a category, copy and paste another icon then click inside the icon to change the number
- 5. Complete the Amenities and Assets Table.
 - a. Add rows to reflect additional amenities, institutions, assets in each category
 - b. Make sure the table row and category match the corresponding legend number
